

Education Services at CCCA

- **Education services are funded through the Virginia Department of Education with Staunton City Schools serving as the fiscal agent for administration of funds.**
- **Staunton City Schools is the employing agency for the education staff and provides supervision of the program. All teachers have valid Virginia Teaching Licenses with performance evaluations conducted according to the policies and procedures of Staunton City Schools. Teachers participate in staff development opportunities to enhance instructional skills and learn about new techniques and strategies.**
- **Students enrolled in school at CCCA receive a full day of instructional services and the educational staff work closely with the students' home school to assure a smooth educational transition and to provide a comparable education by following as closely as possible the students' home school educational program. A continuum of program alternatives is offered to meet the needs of each student. Grades and clock hours are sent back to the home school upon discharge.**
- **Approximately 56% of the students admitted to CCCA have been identified as needing special education services and have existing Individual Education Plans (IEPs). These IEPs are fully implemented while the students are in the center and may include speech therapy, physical therapy, occupational therapy, etc.**
