DIRECTIONS TO THE ROGERS BUILDING CHESTERFIELD MHSS 6801 LUCY CORR BOULEVARD (804) 748-1227

IF YOU ARE TRAVELING NORTH ON 95:

Take Route 288 exit off Route 95 (Exit 62). Continue on 288 (approximately 3-4 miles) to the Iron Bridge/Route 10 East exit. Take this exit and go to the second stop light and turn left onto Lucy Corr Blvd. (the Chesterfield Juvenile Courts Building will be on your left). The entrance to the Rogers Building Visitors' Parking Lot is on the right near the end of this street.

IF YOU ARE TRAVELING SOUTH ON 95:

Take Route 288 exit off Route 95 (Exit 62). Continue on 288 (approximately 3-4 miles) to the Iron Bridge/Route 10 East exit. Take this exit and go to the second stop light and turn left onto Lucy Corr Blvd. (the Chesterfield Juvenile Courts Building will be on your left). The entrance to the Rogers Building Visitors' Parking Lot is on the right near the end of this street.

IF YOU ARE TRAVELING EAST ON ROUTE 60:

Turn right on Courthouse Road. Cross over Hull Street (Rt. 360) and continue on Courthouse Rd. intersection with Route 10. Turn right at light and follow above directions to Lucy Corr Boulevard and parking lot.

IF YOU ARE TRAVELING 460 E:

Take 460 E to 360 East following signs to Richmond and then exit onto Route 288 South. Take Route 10 East Exit. Follow Rt 10 - - and reference above directions.

IF YOU ARE TRAVELING EAST ON 64:

Take the exit that says Powhite/Downtown Expressway. Get on Powhite Parkway. Get off at the Chippenham Parkway (Route 150, South) Exit. Go approximately 3 miles and take Iron Bridge Rd, East (Route 10). Go approximately 4 miles until you see the Chesterfield Courts Building at

the intersection of Rt. 10 & Courthouse Rd, Extended). Go through this intersection to the next traffic light and turn left onto Lucy Corr Blvd. (Follow above directions)

IF YOU ARE TRAVELING WEST ON 64:

Travel 64 West to 295 South. Continue on 295 to the Route 10 (Ironbridge Rd.) Exit (to Chester). Take this exit; you will now be on Route 10. Follow Rt. 10 to 95 North. Take the 288 exit off I-95. Continue on 288 (approximately 3-4 miles) to the Iron Bridge/Route 10 East Exit. Take this exit and go through the first stop light, turning Left at the next light. (SEE ABOVE)

IF YOU ARE TRAVELING FROM SUFFOLK:

Take 460 West to 95 North. Continue up 95 past Petersburg, Colonial Heights, and Chester. Take Route 288 Exit off Route 95. Continue on 288 (approximately 3-4 miles) to the Iron Bridge/Route 10 East Exit. Take this exit and go to through first intersection, Turning Left at the next light onto Lucy Corr Blvd. (SEE ABOVE)

From Richmond

- I64 West to exit 120 (5th Street / VA 631)
- There will be a light at the end of the exit. Turn left onto 5th St. Extended.
- Follow 5th St. Extended for approximately 1 mile. You will see the Albemarle County Office Building on your left.
- Turn right onto Old Lynchburg Road. This is directly across from the turn off to the Albemarle County Office Building.

- I64 East to exit 120 (5th Street / VA 631)
