

PUBLIC NOTICE: The Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services (DBHDS), acting as agent for the Department of Veterans Services (DVS), has received and accepted for consideration an unsolicited proposal under the Public-Private Education Facilities and Infrastructure Act (PPEA) of 2002. The project in the unsolicited proposal is for construction of a 40-bed addition to Sitter & Barfoot Veterans Care Center in Richmond, Virginia. DBHDS intends to evaluate the proposal, may negotiate a comprehensive agreement with the proposer based on the proposal, and will accept for simultaneous consideration any competing proposals that comply with the procedures adopted by the Commonwealth, revised January 17, 2008, and the provisions of the PPEA.
