1 How does option respond to resident and family choice...continue care in state run training center. Resident Choice (most weighted choice). <del>Residents right or ability and/or rep to have a choice where they receive care.</del> Resident/family/AR is appropriately provided all options and resources in order to make informed choices (consistent with all provisions of SA). 2 Maximum health safety and quality of life for individual. Quality of care (inside or outside of TC). Outcome measures ability to <u>measure quality of care. Sentinal event</u>		
3 Access to comparable/appropriate services and supports (in the community and from TC to TC).		
4 Current cost of serving individuals in TC vs those on waiver. Affect the ability of those in the community to access services		
5 Financial impact on Commonwealth. Overall affordability of care system. Siting, permitting, and financing of remaining centers and other community residentials (within a given region). <Process>		
6 Geographic proximity of individuals to families and community support for care for all individuals (TCs and community)
