I. Call to Order

II. Approval/Review of Minutes

Minutes reviewed from April 17, 2012 meeting, with corrections included- Chad Chappel was not present and is no longer with provider. William Daniels is no longer associated

with Healthy Minds and Joyce Bozeman was not present as well, but Shelia Massenburg was in attendance. Lastly, Family Resource Inc. and Supportive Care were not present at last meeting.

### IV. Follow up Business

The current Board advised the committee members that additional board members are needed (2 consumers and one professional). If members are not found, this committee will need to be closed. A potential applicant was being interviewed after the meeting on July 17<sup>th</sup>. This applicant will have to be interviewed on September 7<sup>th</sup> 2012 at the state meeting. All providers were informed to contact Ms. Flowers if they need an application. Committee terms are coming to an end for Mr. Wheeler in 2014 and Mr. Wiley in 2013.

Lenjoy Holding, LLC and Heart to Heart Residential Services were scheduled for request of affiliation, but affiliation requests were not able to be heard due to lack of committee members.

### Expansion of Services

Name change Healthy Minds is now LIFE Young Adult Services, LLC. - they already have an intensive-in home and Mental Health Support program, but seeks expansion for Day Treatment Program. Ms. Flowers informed parties a special meeting will need to take place for consideration of their expansion, contingent on approval of applicant being interviewed this evening.
