- Dominion Day Services- Jody Trejo, liason, shared with the group her program's goals, areas of service, and plans for the Fredericksburg office. Mrs. Trejo requested that two programs be considered for affiliation- Intensive In-Home Services and Mental Health Support Services, which she believes complement each other.
- P.E.O.P.L.E., LLC- Shana Lumb, director of Residential Services, shared information about her group residential home, located in Pelham's Crossing. This will be a 6 bed home for individuals aged 18 and older with intellectual and developmental disabilities (only 4 residents during the first 6 months).

Motion was made by Lynn Delamer to accept these two service providers as affiliates in the FALHRC. Seconded by Marguerite Roche. Motion passed unanimously.

#### **New Member Presentation:**

- Nancy Sorrentino brought her application to become a professional member of the Fredericksburg Area League of Human Rights Committee. She currently serves as a Transition Specialist with Stafford County Public Schools, which involves facilitating employment related skill training, coordinating community links for post secondary placements, supervising job coaches, developing IEPs, and facilitating private day and residential placements.
