A motion was made and seconded: That the Mid-City LHRC accept temporary affiliation of the UP Center Sponsored Placement-Children, and their 9 new homes and 9 previous homes for 90 days pending their receiving licenses from DMHMRSAS. Passed

A motion was made, seconded and passed that the LHRC approve the temporary affiliation for 90 days of Community Solutions programs; Day Treatment Services, a school based program and Mental Health Support Services pending their receiving a license from DMHMRSAS. Passed

Report from the Advocate: Mr. Prost indicated that there were changes coming to his office including a possible location change. He indicated that there is a required process for programs seeking temporary affiliation and that he would send out an email to all programs delineating the various steps.
