Report from the Advocate: Mr. Prost reported that their office secretary was retiring. The position is not filled currently. Mr. Prost reviews the State Human Rights Committee (SHRC) vote to approve a new set of by-laws and a new cooperative agreement to be implemented by each LHRC in the Commonwealth. Mr. Prost copied several handouts that address the changes the SHRC wishes to have implemented. Mr. Prost summarize to the providers the implementation memo, model LHRC by-laws, model cooperative agreement, and a document showing the SHRC's responses to comments submitted by the Human Rights Advocates All changes go in effect as of June 2011.
