Jessica Fanning presented on the **Hopewell House** for Independepent Living. The Hopewell House is a non-profit organization established in the state of Virginia 2005. The pursue of the Hopewell House is to facilitate the "psych-education" and treatment of individuals with mental illness and disabilities sin a campus/residential setting.

Jimmie Roberson presented on the **Women's Center** and specifically psychological assessment services focusing on the following areas: assessment for Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder, Diagnosing mental disorders, determining differential diagnosis, measuring intelligence for academic placement,

clarifying interpersonal or communication problems, and understanding the causes of behavioral problems.

Lamar Taylor presented on **Global Interventions** and Therapeutic Day Treatment services they are providing in 5 Alexandria Schools. Therapeutic Day Treatment is a school-based program designed to successfully address mental health, emotional, behavioral and substance abuse issues that create a barrier to effective learning.
