I. Call to order

The meeting was called to order by Sam Moore, Chair.

V. Advocate's Report

The Advocates office is now fully-staffed. He reminded the providers that this LHRC is recruiting to fill a general and consumer position which will be vacant in July. Applications should be returned to him. He informed the audience that an agreement with the Department of Justice and the Department of Behavioral Health and Disability Services will result in closing four of the five training centers run by the state. SEVTC is to remain open. A discharge from a state facility to a community program will require a visit from the advocate and the licensing department before and after the transfer is completed. The licensing department will be hiring seven more positions across the state. The state has hired a Community Integration Manager for each facility to assist in finding community placement for those folks leaving training centers.

He also reminded providers to email their quarterly reports to all committee members and to him. The dates of the quarters are

January 1-March 30	due April 15

He also stressed that even though the provider may not have customers the reports are still due. Failure to comply with report requirements could jeopardize affiliation and licensing.
