The treatment often consists of SA groups, rather than targeting MH stabilization. The intake staff are sometimes inaccessible. One recent admission was delayed for a week due to the unresponsiveness of the Intake person. Based on the collective experience in our CSB's ES program, these programs seem to offer a better option for "step down" from an acute inpatient facility, rather than for direct admission.
