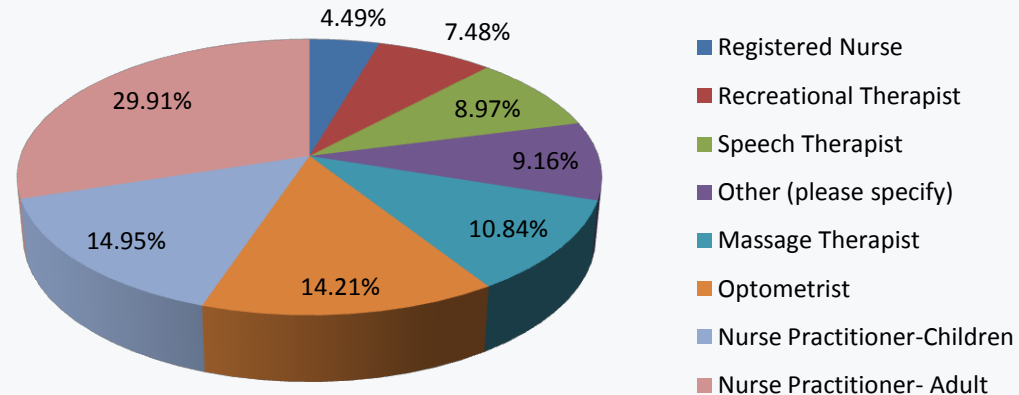

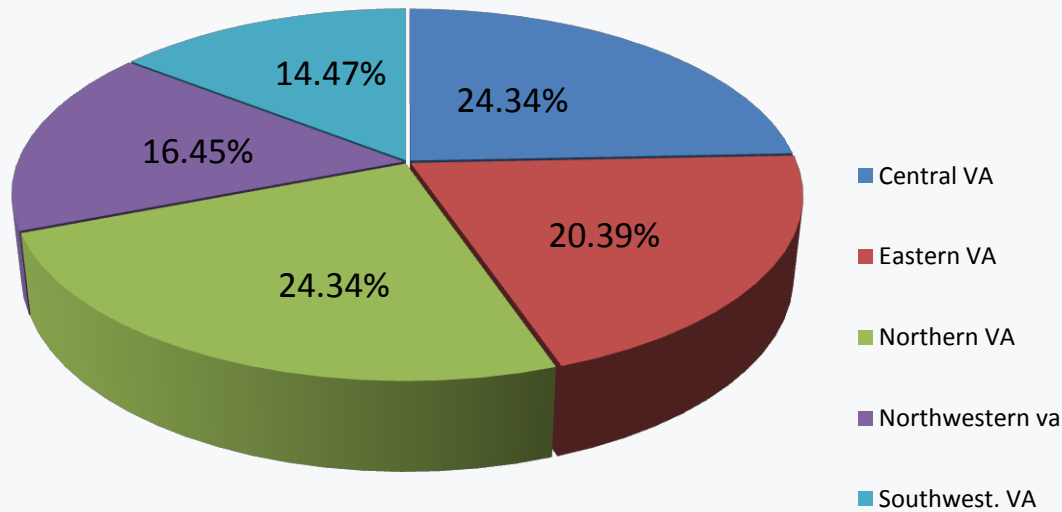

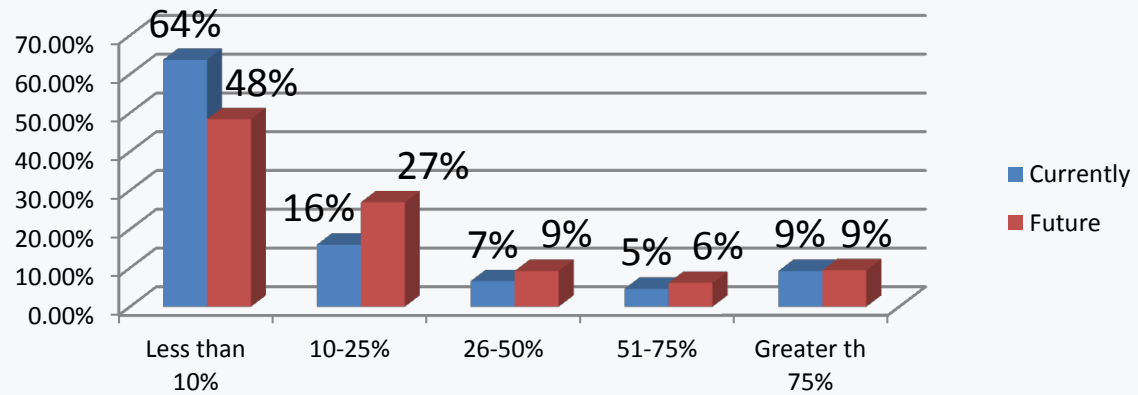

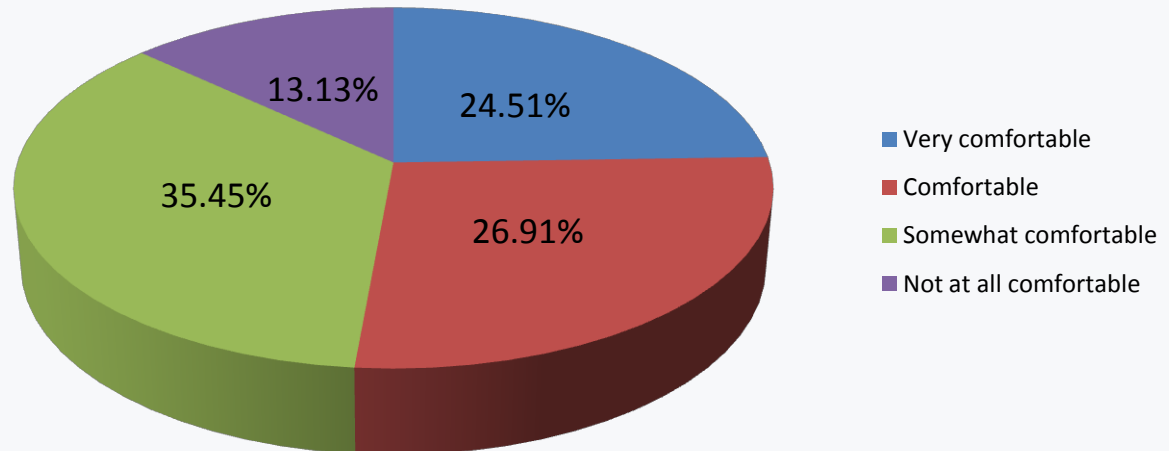

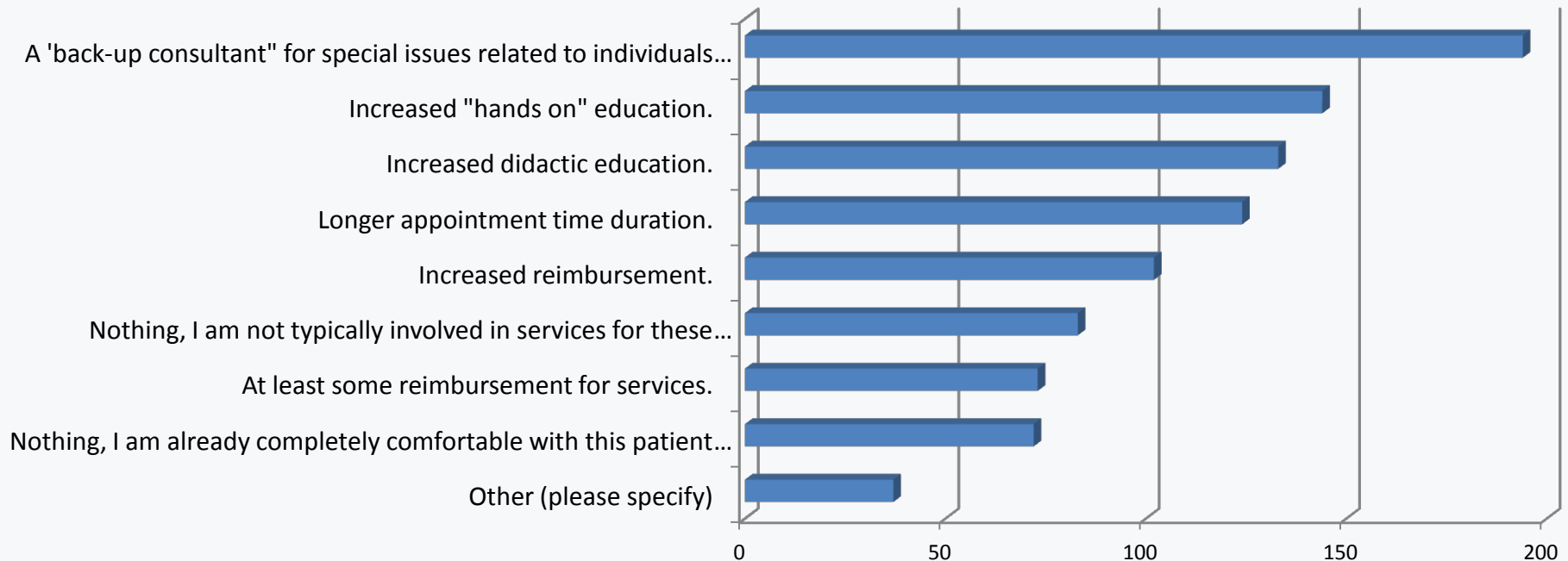

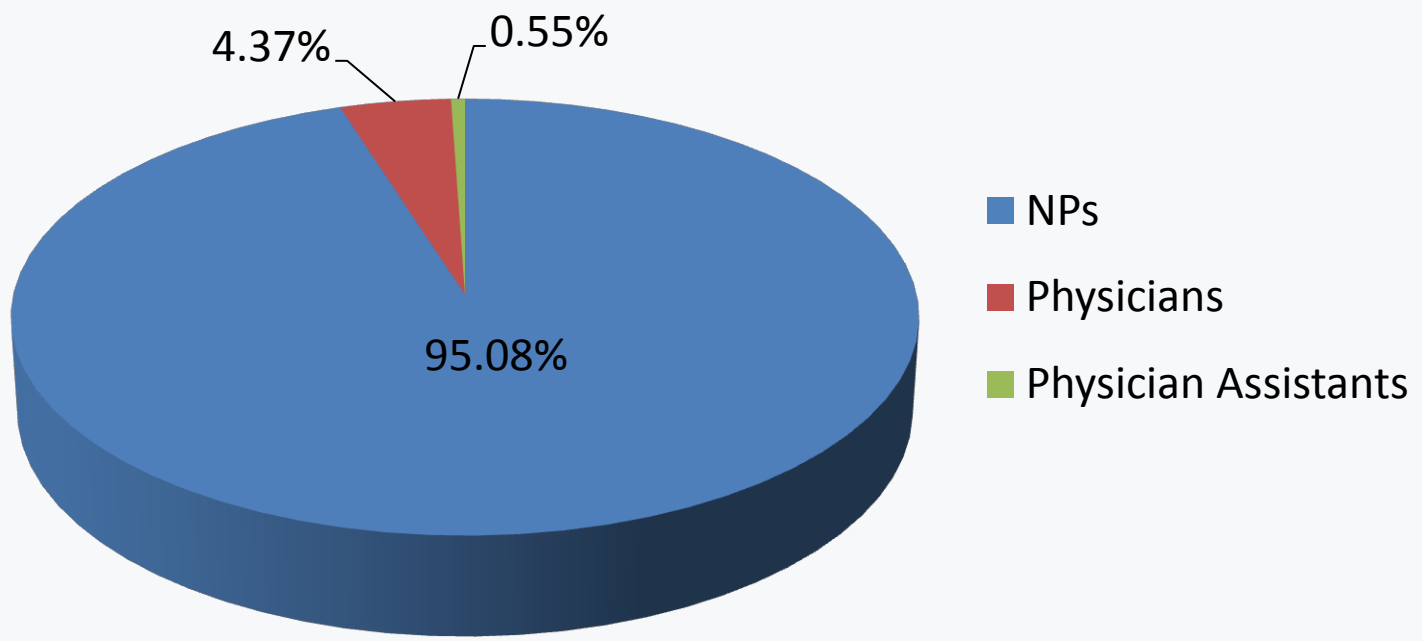
What, if anything, would make you more comfortable with providing services to patients with intellectual and developmental disabilities? (Check all that apply).

Provider Credentials



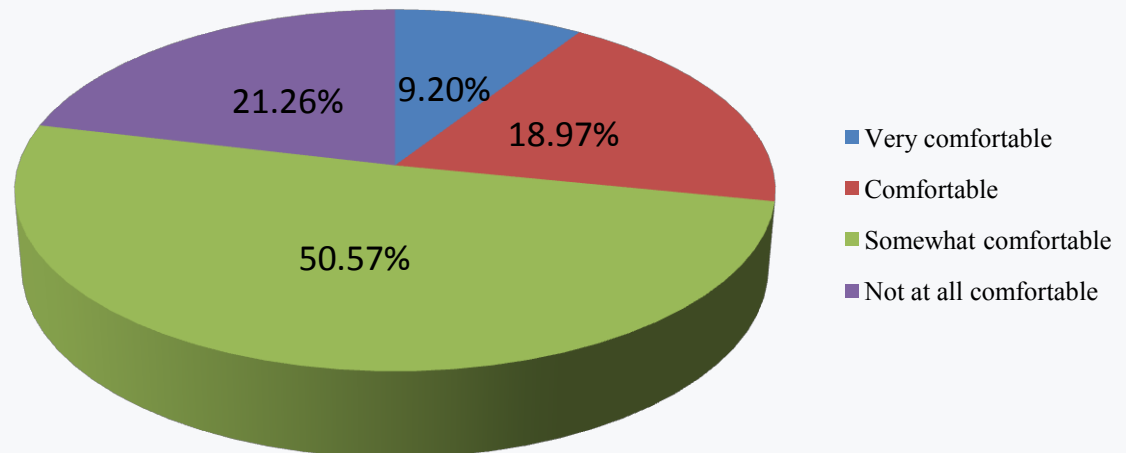




# Perceived Preparedness for Individuals with IDD
