

Dear Stakeholders:

The DBHDS Office of Licensing will be conducting training related to the [Amendments to align the Children’s Residential Regulations with ASAM criteria](#) and the [Amendments to align the General Regulations with ASAM criteria](#) effective February 20, 2021, with an implementation date of July 1, 2021. This training will also include additional information on the licensure process for substance use disorder providers who will need to submit a service modification to apply for the appropriate ASAM Level of Care license. To accommodate the large number of licensed providers and varying scheduling needs, two sessions are planned on the same training.

Who Should Attend: The individual responsible for implementing the Licensing Regulations within licensed services as well as the person responsible for submitting the service modification application. Due to capacity restrictions within Zoom, the training is limited to two people per provider organization. The slide presentation will be sent out to providers soon after the training concludes via constant contact and will be posted on the Office of Licensing website, so anyone who did not attend will be able to access the information shortly after the presentations.
